FG FINANCIAL PREFERRED INCOME FUND

QUARTERLY REPORT FOR THE PERIOD ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 2010

Investment Objective

FG Financial Preferred Income Fund is a fixed income Fund that aims to provide the highest possible level of return while still maintaining liquidity and preserving capital. The Fund seeks to provide stable returns to unit holders in excess of average term deposit rates

Investment Strategy

FG Financial Preferred Income Fund invests predominantly in government bonds and bank deposits but enhances its yield through investing in a diversified portfolio of mortgages, preference shares and corporate bonds. Its emphasis is on principal protection and constant income generation.

The Fund carries a low level of risk to the investor based primarily on investment in a combination of short-term financial instruments and government guaranteed securities.

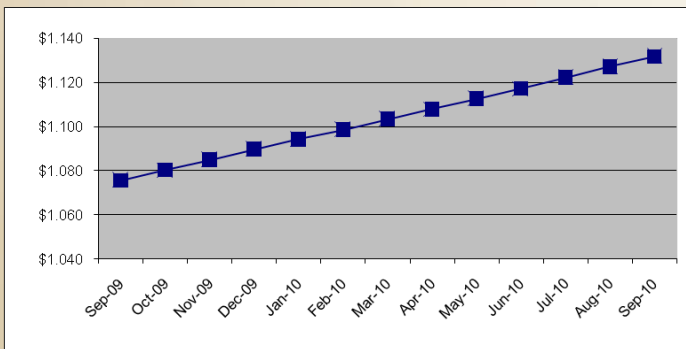
Third Quarter 2010 Review

FG Financial Preferred Income Fund ended the third quarter with a net asset value (NAV) per share of \$1.1318, providing a return of 1.30%, outperforming benchmark returns of 0.90% by 40 basis points over the same period. The Fund yielded year-to-date returns of 3.85%, again beating out its benchmark, the weighted average bank term deposit rate by 116 basis points, which reported returns of 2.69%. The Fund reported 12-month returns of 5.22% compared to benchmark returns of 3.65%. The Fund's average annualized yield since inception approximates 5.86%, compared to its benchmark, which reflected average annualized returns of 3.78% over the same period.

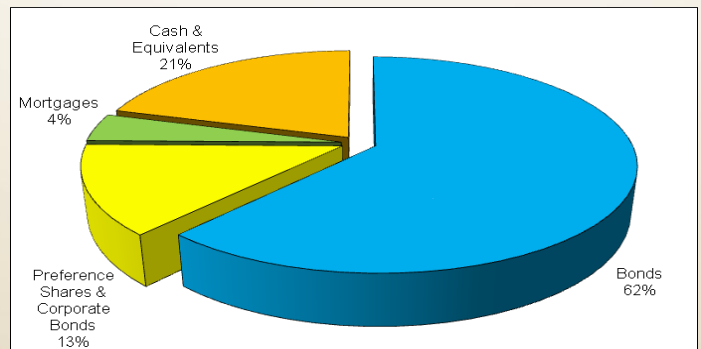
Year-to-date, the Fund has experienced substantial growth as investors sought lower levels of risk by safeguarding their investments from exposure to the volatility of the equities market. As a result, year-to-date, net assets available to shareholders increased by approximately \$525,000 attributable to net subscriptions of \$383,000 and net investment income of \$143,000. During the quarter, our available funds were channeled into investments of \$150,000 in government bonds and \$60,000 in preference shares.

Our long-term objectives remain the same...maximizing fund participant returns at an acceptable level of risk.
